

FSRC CLUB RULES

1. Parking/registration: obey NO PARKING signs and markings. Do not block entrance to club house. Speed limit is 15 mph. Everyone, including children and guests, must register at the front desk upon arrival at the club.
2. Parents are expected to exercise adequate supervision over their children at all time, so that they will not interfere with the convenience and enjoyment of adults. Parents are encouraged to review the club rules with their children.
3. Children under 10 years of age MUST be accompanied by an adult or babysitter at all times. Children are not to be left at the club without supervision. Babysitters on duty will not be subject to guest fees.
4. All games and other activities will be conducted in the areas designated by the club manager.
5. No member or guest is allowed to reprimand an employee.
6. The club is not responsible for personal property left in the club house, locker room, pool area, vehicles or elsewhere on club premises.
7. Any property of the club that is broken or damaged by a member or their guest, will be promptly paid for by that member.
8. The club assumes no responsibility and members or their guests can have no claim against the club for the property of members or guests brought into or left in the club buildings or grounds.
9. The club assumes no responsibility and members or their guests have no claim against the club for any accident or injury to any person or their property.
10. No pets or animals are permitted on club property at any time.
11. Rule violations on the part of members and guests can be called to the attention of the member by the club manager or pool supervisor. Violations will be referred to the board of directors for proper action.
12. Containers for refuse will be provided by the club and used by everyone.
13. All beverages consumed on premises must be in non-breakable containers. The use of alcoholic beverages is confined to the patio outside the club house, grassy area around the pool and the pavilion. Alcohol is not permitted on tennis courts or in the pool and must be done in moderation.
14. Suggestions or concerns must be made to the club manager or board of directors.
