

FSRC POOL RULES

1. The pool supervisor is in charge and has complete control and authority to enforce all rules and regulations, including the limiting of activities or anyone disturbing the enjoyment of others or endangering the safety of anyone.
2. Observation of all community recognized rules of sanitation and safety will be expected of everyone, including children.
3. Expectoration, blowing noses, spouting water or any other activities that may pollute the water are prohibited and admission to the pool area will be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, infection, or wearing bandages.
4. All bathers must shower before entering the pool.
5. No person may use the pool at any time unless a lifeguard is on duty at the poolside.
6. Air inflated tubes, masks, jackets or other paraphernalia are not allowed in the pool unless approved by the pool supervisor or the guard on duty.
7. Children who have passed prescribed swimming tests and have written permission from their parents, or at the discretion of the pool supervisor or their designated representative, may utilize all pool facilities.
8. Nobody may use the deep end of the pool until they have demonstrated to the satisfaction of the pool supervisor or designated guard that they are a capable swimmer.
9. Smoking is not permitted.
10. No running, pushing, wrestling or undue disturbance is permitted in or around the pool area and ball playing is only permitted when the pool is not crowded and at the discretion of the pool supervisor.
11. No glass, rigid plastic or breakable containers of any kind are permitted in or around the pool area.
12. No changing of clothing, diapers or swimming apparel is permitted anywhere outside the locker rooms.
13. Bathing suits of socially acceptable standards are required and babies must wear swim diapers.
14. Tennis tournament participants will be permitted to use the pool facilities for that day only.
